

**Remembering James – ‘A Weekend of Rock n’ Polo’  
Cowdray Park Polo Club, 17-18 May 2008**

**A memorial of music  
and matches**

Organised by the parents of James Wentworth-Stanley, who took his own life in December 2006, the ‘Remembering James weekend of Rock n’ Polo’ was met with extraordinary support as the generosity of some 750 guests at Cowdray Park in May raised a remarkable £600,000 for the memorial fund set up in his name to help tackle the problems of youth suicide and depression.

Saturday night’s ‘rock’ aspect saw high-profile musical entertainment, including special rock performances from Mike Rutherford, Ringo Starr, Gary Brooker and The Jones Gang – a group made up of members from The Who and Small Faces, in the shape of Kenney Jones, Rick Wills and Robert Hart.

The evening also saw a fantastic auction in aid of The James Wentworth-Stanley Memorial Fund, as well as a separate silent auction, where the quality of all the lots and the generosity of the bidders was wonderful. A selection of specialist holidays in all corners of the globe, one-off sporting, cultural and culinary experiences and unique money-can’t-buy celebrity treats raised £600,000. Since James’s memorial fund has no running costs, all this money will be used directly in valuable projects helping young people.

An asado lunch on Sunday followed before the final and subsidiary final of the Trippett’s Challenge, the former being played for the James Wentworth-Stanley Cup, a high-goal tournament endowed for the second year by James’ stepfather, The Marques of Milford Haven.

It was his Bronco’s team who claimed victory in the final, taking the cup from the 2007 winners, Ellerston, 10-8. The Marchioness of Milford Haven then went on to win the subsidiary final, where her Jaeger-LeCoultre team beat Sumaya 13-12 in a seventh chukka.

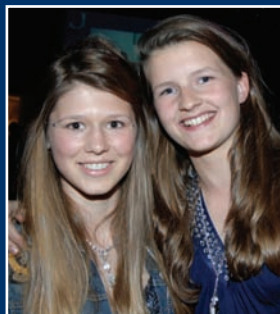
